139	Annual Inspection Report The Clerk suggested that an alternative safety surfacing could be used which is grass seeded over the top and would get rid of the need to top bark levels up. Costs to be investigated. Sand pit – sort liner out, top up with more sand, rub down edges and varnish. A new seat is required on the see-saw – replacement to be obtained. Repair any rubber surfacing requiring attention. Bark needs topped up – supply to be obtained. Play equipment in the Eden Street play area needs rubbed down and re-painted. Sweep bark off platform on the ship. Ken and the grounds maintenance team to attend to any additional repairs they see necessary after considering the annual inspection report.
